SUBMITTING YOUR PHOTOS & VIDEOS

In order to give your horse the most potential to succeed in our online auction, the Welsh Pony and Cob Society of Australia Inc. require the following photos and videos requirements:

- Up to 10 photos and 1 YouTube link limit. (YouTube links only, we do not accept video files) - *YouTube video link is optional. PLEASE NOTE - If you want to have a specific photo as the 'hero'/main photo for your listing please advise the office when submitting your photos.*
- A CURRENT DATED PHOTO WITH DATE PROOF (no more than 28 days old and digital dates will not be accepted). BODY SHOT (the horses entire body MUST BE VISIBLE) and MUST INCLUDE A PIECE OF PAPER WITH THE DATE CLEARLY VISIBLE IN THE FRAME - YOU CAN NOT ADD A DIGITAL DATE TO A PHOTO YOU HAVE ALREADY TAKEN. This condition of nomination is NON NEGOTIABLE.
NO VERIFIED IMAGE – NOMINATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!!
- Photographers must be acknowledged in the description section of the nomination form.

HELPFUL HINTS:

It is advisable to photograph your horse from front, back and side views.

PHOTOGRAPHS: (Max 10 images) - These should showcase any old scarring, feet condition, current body condition, your horses conformation and all aspects of your horse. Good quality images are a must.

VIDEOS: (1 only) - This video can be of the horse being ridden/led/being groomed or even something as simple as being interacted with i.e.: feeding a treat, picking up feet. Something that will show your horse being easy to handle.
