



APPLICATION TO BECOME A TIER 2

Eligibility checklist

- You must be a minimum of 25 years of age
- You must have attended a WPCSA Judge Seminar within the previous 2 years
- You must be a WPCSA (or approved overseas Society) current Full financial member (or Associate member linked to a Full membership) and be the nominee of that membership and have been a member for at least 5 consecutive years.
- You must have judged a minimum of 5 shows.
- You must not have any convictions relating to animal cruelty or child abuse.
- You have read the document "Do you want to become a Judge" and in particular the sections "Probationary Judging and Progression to Tier 2", "Appointment as a Tier 2 Judge" and "Eligibility for Assessment" and accept that approval for assessment will be at the discretion of COM.
- You understand that in order to be eligible for appointment as a Tier 2 Welsh In-Hand judge you or your immediate family must have bred at least 5 Pure Welsh animals or bred &/or owned &/or produced and exhibited a minimum of 10 Pure Welsh animals over a minimum 5 year period where it can be determined by COM that you have been directly involved in the breeding &/or production decisions made. Production is defined as "a person involved in the training, conditioning and/or exhibition of show or competition horses". This criterion does not apply for appointment to the Part Welsh In-Hand, Ridden or harness panels.
- You understand that should your application to be assessed be successful that a bond of \$100 will be required to secure your place at an Assessment. This will be refunded following attendance.

To be appointed to the Tier 2 panel of judges you will need to complete a Closed Book Test for each section applied for gaining a 80% pass mark, undergo a practical assessment where you will “judge” two classes of ponies/cobs and be interviewed by 2 Society Assessors.

Should there be insufficient space on this form you may attach further documentation. Comprehensive information is encouraged to assist with assessing your application.

In submitting this application you accept that approval to be assessed as a Tier 2 Judge is at the discretion of COM who will consider information documented in this application together with and Probationary or Judging reports previously submitted to the Society. You also understand that should your application be successful you will be assessed by 2 Society Assessors and that their decision pertaining to your application will be final. Following assessment you may be appointed to Tier 2 without restriction, be required to complete one or more successful Probationary judging appointments prior to appointment or be required to undergo further training and assessment at a future date.
